We are writing with regards to the recent tragic incident at 16th and Wallace involving a Lord Byng student. Here is the latest in terms of response from the city: City of Vancouver upgrading intersection after teen struck by a car¹⁴.

The PAC would love to hear from you. We ask you to bring forward concerns, ideas, and suggestions on how to improve road safety and reduce congestion around JQ and the neighbouring schools. Please include your comments in this document here ¹⁵. We have had discussions with our school Admin., PACs at Lord Byng and QE, and other stakeholders. We will also discuss this issue in the PAC meeting next week.

The streets around the school are very busy during drop off and pick up. Please be patient and mindful of all the parking and traffic rules when dropping and/or picking up your child. We kindly recommend, if possible, parking a block or two away from the school and walk in to come get your child.

The VMSA is a non-profit sports association providing softball programming for young athletes up to 19 years old. Our organization provides opportunities primarily for girls and young women in the City of Vancouver, however, we are inclusive of all gender identifications.

We believe increasing youth participation in softball is extremely important for girls and young women, as it will enhance their physical, mental, emotional, and cognitive development. More specifically, VMSA believes that providing access to softball provides young female athletes opportunities to develop: softball skills (across multiple areas); confidence; leadership; decision making; friendship and


