

Road Safety Updates



We are sending you an update on road safety at our school neighbourhood following the devastating incident involving a Lord Byng student. Over the last two months, the PACs at Lord Byng, JQ, and Queen Elizabeth Elementary (W16th Schools Safety Coalition) have been collaborating to advocate for significant, and long term changes along 16th avenue stretch shared by our schools, and the neighbouring areas. We have also been seeking inputs from Vision Zero Vancouver, traffic advisories from DPAC, and Vancouver Coastal Health. We thank the JQ community for all the inputs provided.

The school coalition has put together this briefing piece for advocacy purposes with all relevant information. Please do take a look. Briefing Paper: W 16th Ave Schools Safety Coalition⁷ The social media page for the coalition is here⁸. In addition, our JQ PAC Safety coordinators, Risa Sargent and Miranda Holmes had written to the City of Vancouver (CoV) Traffic Engineering team stressing the need for more crossing time for pedestrians at 16th and Crown intersection. The CoV team has responded that they are planning to re-time the pedestrian phase at this specific intersection with an additional six-seconds to cross safely. This change is expected to be completed in 2024.

Finally, as was circulated by the school Principal last week, Mayor Ken Sim sent the following to our school community: Mayor's letter to JQ⁹ with further safety measures near Lord Byng and JQ. We will keep you all updated on the above. If you have any questions or comments, please write to us by responding to this newsletter.

Liaise with hot lunch vendor - currently Calhoun's Catering - to create hot lunch menus, make payments to vendor and troubleshoot any issues.

Be willing to receive and respond to parent inquiries. Liaise with school administration regarding any issues with hot lunch at the school.

Become the Master Admin for the online ordering program - MunchaLunch. Send any relevant updates regarding hot lunch to school admin and PAC for distribution to the JQ parent population.

Liaise with the Pizza Day coordinator to send the pizza ordering reports from MunchaLunch to the pizza vendor.

Lead the decision-making regarding any changes to the hot lunch vendors or continued use of the online ordering system.
