First Week of School



First Day of School: On Tuesday September 3rd, all students in grades 1 - 7 will attend for one hour from 9:00 to 10:00 am. Please line-up in the same spot as last year. New students to the school and any student who does not recall last year's meeting spot, please wait at the bottom of the main staircase and a staff member will assist you. Most students will be spending the first few days with last year's teacher.

New kindergarten students will not attend school on this day and will follow a gradual entry schedule which begins on Wednesday.

Wednesday, September 4th: Will be the first regular school day, from 9:00 am to 2:58 pm for students in grades 1 - 7. Students will once again meet at the same spot as Tuesday (and last year).

Please have your child bring a mid-morning snack for recess and a packed lunch and note that we are an allergy-aware school.

Please note that on Wednesday, students in last year's Kindergarten classes - Div 15 (Mme Aubry) and Div 16 (Mme Campbell), current grade 1s, will be greeted by Mme Brigitte and Mme Erica and will go to the Library and Room 206.

New Kindergarten students should meet Mme Dana and Mme Campbell on the basketball court as per the schedule emailed in early July. Group A will meet at 9:10 am and be dismissed at 10:10 am from the same location. Group B will meet at 10:20 am and be dismissed at 11:20 am.

2024-2025 Classes: As soon as we receive authorization from the District, students will be assigned to their new class for the school year. There will be a number of combination classes and we would like to assure everyone that all of our students will be learning and engaged at their grade level and that there are many benefits to combination classes.

Confirming Attendance and Placement: If the school cannot verify your child's attendance by noon on **Friday, September 6th**, your child's space may be given to another student on the waitlist. Thank you to those parents who have already notified the school of a later return date.

Allergy-Aware: The Vancouver School District and École Jules Quesnel are committed to providing as safe a learning and teaching environment as is practicable for anaphylactic students. In addition to the precautions taken by school staff and the families of allergic children, all JQ families are asked to be 'allergy-aware' and to consider the following strategies to minimize the risk of exposure for allergic children.

- Try to avoid sending your child to school with allergenic foods.
- Encourage your child to wash their hands regularly, especially before and after eating.
- Discourage sharing of food at school.

All VSB schools are also 'air aware', meaning students, staff and visitors are encouraged to use fragrance free and unscented shampoos, hairsprays, deodorants, lotions, and other products, and avoiding application of perfume and cologne.

School Supplies: These are not required for the first two weeks. If supplies are needed, the classroom teacher will provide a list of items in due course.



Traffic flow and safety



Students, families and staff are encouraged to consider active modes of transportation for getting to and from school. There is only limited parking around JQ. If you are driving, consider the "Drive to Five" initiative. Park five minutes away and walk to school.

Please refer to the image for information regarding parking and traffic flow around JQ. Traffic should flow clockwise around the school.

Please also note that there has been a change to traffic flow at West 16th Avenue and Wallace. Vehicles will no longer be allowed to make a left turn onto West 16th Avenue.

Kindergarten Information Meeting - Wednesday, September 4th



An information meeting will be held on **Wednesday, September 4th at 6 pm for families of new kindergarten students.** One or both parents should attend. The meetings will take place in the kindergarten classrooms on the ground floor, rooms 139 and 101A. Please enter the school via the doors off the parking lot on West 14th Avenue. Class lists will be posted at the entrance and parents should go to the classroom of their child. Please note that paid parking is in effect in the parking lot so you may wish to park on a nearby street.

Personal Digital Devices during school hours



As you may know, in January 2024, the Province of B.C. mandated all school boards to update their Codes of Conduct to limit students' use of personal digital devices during school hours.

Elementary

Personal digital devices are now restricted throughout the instructional day (9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.). This includes class time, recess and lunch. Devices must be turned off or set to silent mode and kept out of sight for the entire school day.

Secondary

In secondary schools, personal digital devices must be turned off or placed on silent mode before students enter the classroom and remain silent during instructional time. Personal digital devices are not permitted for use during class/instructional time unless an educator has given permission.

Schools may provide additional information or guidelines to support the updated Code of Conduct⁵ (section 1.3.5). We kindly ask everyone to join us in encouraging students to develop digital literacy skills and use technology solely for educational purposes while at school.

Family Accident Reimbursement Plan



The Vancouver School Board has made arrangements for families to voluntarily purchase student accident insurance through the Family Accident Reimbursement Plan, underwritten by Industrial Alliance Insurance and Financial Services Inc.

The Family Accident Reimbursement Plan offers protection against the unexpected costs of injury from accidents, and is especially valuable for families who:
