Watch for a sample card with instructions on how to order your child's art made into beautiful keepsake art products in the coming weeks.




We would like to return the completed Art Cards by November 8th to ensure any orders placed are received at the beginning of December in time for the festive season postal dates.

Grade 6 Immunization Clinic - Monday, November 4





All students play outside during mid morning and lunch recesses. Please make sure that appropriate outside clothing is worn to school for cold and wet weather conditions. We suggest rain boots, a water resistant jacket and mittens and hats when the weather becomes colder. Umbrellas are ok too; please remind your child about appropriate umbrella use.

It is also advisable to have a spare set of clothing in the classroom which includes a pair or socks, especially important for younger students. Slips and falls happen quite frequently in wet conditions and students often need additional clothing.
