

# Winter Concert - Tuesday, December 17



**Tuesday December 17, 2024, from 6:00-7:30 pm**, for a winter concert. Please read on for details.

- The concert will take place in Byng's auditorium. Students will have the opportunity to see each other perform during a dress rehearsal during school hours the afternoon of December 17.
- School staff have kindly agreed to make themselves available from 5:30 pm until the end
  of the concert to supervise students. Please let your child's teacher know by email if
  your child will NOT be participating in the concert.
- Band students (Divisions 1, 2 and 3) must arrive at the JQ music room from 5:15 pm to no later than 5:30 pm to unpack instruments and go to Byng auditorium.
- All other students can arrive and go to their classrooms between 5:30 and 5:45 pm.
   Please be on time. Students will wait with school staff in their classrooms until it's their time to perform. After their performance, students will return to their classrooms to wait for the end of the concert.
- The Choir will perform after the band so are not required to arrive early and should arrive between 5:30 and 5:45 pm and go to their classroom.

- Byng auditorium will be open for seating from 5:30 pm so the concert can begin promptly at 6:00 pm. Spectators will enter Byng auditorium through the main auditorium entrance off Crown Street.
- Due to the limited seating capacity of Byng auditorium, audience is limited to immediate family only, 2 spectators per student.
- Spectators are asked to stay for the entire performance, please.
- Students will be with their teachers in their classrooms at JQ before and after their performances. After the concert, students will be dismissed from their regular drop off/pick up locations outside JQ. Families, please exit Byng auditorium and pick up your children promptly.

# JQ Salmon Stream - walking school bus

We are excited to announce the launch of our Walking School Bus (WSB) initiative, also known as the JQ Salmon Stream! (Thank you to Barend for coming up with this great name at our PAC meeting!) This program aims to encourage active and safe transportation to school while fostering a sense of community and fun among our students and families.

The idea for the Walking School Bus was discussed during a PAC meeting last year, with representatives from the Society for Children and Youth of BC present to address questions and

concerns. For more details, you can review the meeting minutes here<sup>16</sup> and the accompanying presentation here<sup>17</sup>.

#### **How It Works**

We aim to kickstart the JQ Salmon Stream with all participants walking together, which helps to build community spirit while promoting active and safe transportation to school. Currently, two parents **Valerie Balaski and Nafisa Fera**, both parents of Grade 4 and Grade 2 students have volunteered to lead the initial routes. Each leader will walk one morning a week starting at a designated meeting point. **Over time**, we hope more parents will volunteer to expand the number of walking routes and days.

#### **Current Routes**

- 1. **Nafisa's Route:** Meeting at the bus stop at 10th and Trimble (Shell station) at 8:30 am every Thursday. This route will proceed along 11th to 15th Avenue, with opportunities to meet families along the way.
- 2. **Valerie's Route:** Meeting at 10th and Blenheim St. at 8:25 am every Friday. This route will proceed along 10th Ave., Alma St, 12th Ave., Wallace St. JQ along 14th Ave.

The group features subgroups for each route, allowing for streamlined communication and updates on meeting times and routes.



# Information for kindergarten families from Canadian Parents for French



# TIPS for supporting your child's French education.

Most French immersion parents have either a limited knowledge of French or cannot speak the language at all. If you don't speak French yourself, it is not suggested you read to your child in French now. However, any reading that you do in your first language is recommended and the reading skills that are learned, such as vocabulary development and reading from left to right, can be transferred to French.

Being able to read words and sound out letters are important aspects of learning to read but true reading involves reading for meaning and making connections with our own personal experiences. Children should be encouraged to death what they read through pictures, questions and discussion and refetting the story. This leads to greater understanding and comprehension.

#### Here are some simple suggestions for children in primary immersion:

- Be enthusiastic and positive.
- Read often to your child in English (or your first language)
- Provide French resources eg. French dictionaries, DVDs, CDs, books, comic books.
- Consider putting them into a French language summer day camp.
- Discover French internet web sites.
- Join the local chapter of your Canadian Parents for French to network with other immersion parents, access services and to keep informed about developments in French second language education.
- Sign up for an adult French course geared to French immersion parents.
- Listen to French radio and watch French shows or movies.
- Hire a tutor or babysitter who speaks French to play with your child.

Try to develop the best relationship possible between you and your child's teacher, making teamwork the main theme. Asking about your children's honework and praising them for its completion as well as allowing them to tell you about their day will help create a more positive environment about school in general.
