

We will be working in your area on behalf of BC Hydro and would like to inform you of the upcoming work.

Our work involves installing underground civil infrastructure on public property impacting both sides of Crown St (2900 Block) between W 13th Ave and W 14th Ave.

Generally, we will work weekdays between 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.

To ensure the safety of the public and our employees, temporary disruptions to vehicle and pedestrian traffic may be necessary. Lane and road access will be maintained and directed by traffic control personnel.

Personal Digital Device Survey



In July of 2024, as required by the BC Ministry of Education and Child Care, and in order to foster a safe and focused learning environment, the VSB Student Code of Conduct was revised to restrict students' use of personal digital devices (cell phones, tablets, electronic devices).

In elementary schools, students' personal digital devices are to be turned off and out of sight from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm. In secondary schools the same expectation holds during instructional time. The use of personal digital devices is permitted only for educational purposes, when directed by an educator or as outlined in a student's IEP.

This anonymous survey, open until February 28, 2025, aims to assess the impact of this change on students, classrooms, and learning within our school district.

The parking lot at Jules Quesnel Elementary School is for the exclusive use of the school from 7:00 AM to 4:00 PM on school days.


Public pay parking in the JQ lot is available on school days from 4:00 PM until 7:00 AM, and 24 hours a day on non-school days.

Kindergarten Choice Program Registration



It is time for the last step in the Kindergarten Choice Program Registration.

The online District Choice Program is now open and will close on February 4, 2025.

To guarantee sibling priority, please ensure that your child entering Kindergarten in September 2025 is registered online for the Choice Program before February 4. Here is the link: https://kchoice.vsb.bc.ca/

To date, 21 families have informed us of a younger sibling starting Kindergarten in September.

Once the VSB lottery has taken place, an email will be sent to families (mid to late February) to confirm your child's spot or of an applicant's status on the waitlist (non-siblings).

Obtaining Kindergarten PENs and Sibling PENs

There are three ways for parents to access their child's PEN which is required for the online K-choice Application Process:

- 1. Parents can retrieve their child's PEN as well as the PEN for an older sibling during the online application process using the available PEN retrieval function on the KChoice application site (families can access it during the registration window).
- 2. Contact the school where the child is registered schools are encouraged to provide PENs upon parent request provided the identity of the parent can be verified.
- 3. During the application window Tuesday Jan 7 to Tues February 4 there will be telephone support available M-F between 9:00 am and 3:30 pm at Tel: 604-713-5688. Parents also have the option of e-mailing: vsbkchoiceapply@vsb.bc.ca⁶.

Please contact the school if you have any questions or require any assistance.

Swatch - a student has lost a Swatch with a soccer ball strap. Please return to the office if found.


Apple AirTag - a student has lost an AirTag marked "R". Please return to the office if found.

JQ Salmon Stream - walking school bus



We are excited to announce the launch of our Walking School Bus (WSB) initiative, also known as the JQ Salmon Stream! (Thank you to Barend for coming up with this great name at our PAC meeting!) This program aims to encourage active and safe transportation to school while fostering a sense of community and fun among our students and families.

The idea for the Walking School Bus was discussed during a PAC meeting last year, with representatives from the Society for Children and Youth of BC present to address questions and concerns. For more details, you can review the meeting minutes here¹⁵ and the accompanying presentation here¹⁶.

We aim to kickstart the JQ Salmon Stream with all participants walking together, which helps to build community spirit while promoting active and safe transportation to school. Currently, two parents **Valerie Balaski and Nafisa Fera**, both parents of Grade 4 and Grade 2 students have volunteered to lead the initial routes. Each leader will walk one morning a week starting at a designated meeting point. **Over time**, we hope more parents will volunteer to expand the number of walking routes and days.

Current Routes

- 1. **Nafisa's Route:** Meeting at the bus stop at 10th and Trimble (Shell station) at 8:30 am every Thursday. This route will proceed along 11th to 15th Avenue, with opportunities to meet families along the way.
- 2. **Valerie's Route:** Meeting at 10th and Blenheim St. at 8:25 am every Friday. This route will proceed along 10th Ave., Alma St, 12th Ave., Wallace St. JQ along 14th Ave.

The program follows best practices outlined in active school travel initiatives. Volunteers accompanying children are not assuming additional liability, provided they act responsibly. For more details, we encourage you to review this document, which addresses common concerns:

Ontario Active School Travel Liability Guidelines 18.

Key excerpt:

"By volunteering to accompany children on their walk to and from school, parents are not assuming responsibility for anything that may happen during the trip. Parents are expected to act responsibly... Unless they have acted in a negligent manner and that negligence caused the injury, they have nothing to fear."
