

Safe Arrival and Reporting Student Absences



To report your child's absence, please call **604-713-5159**, **Ext. 39**, **or email jquattendance@vsb.bc.ca**³ prior to 9:00 AM on the first day of the absence. If your child arrives late to school, they should report to the office and sign-in.

Please ask your child to check in with the Office if arriving late, this way we know your child is on site. Thank you.

Please remember if your child is late or absent or leaving school early to inform before or after school care and outside of school time programs.

Class Casting

Class casting, the process of organizing students into divisions for next school year, begins at the end of the current school year. When determining placements for next year, school staff make every attempt to place students in balanced, effective learning environments, taking into account individual learning styles, social dynamics and specific learning needs, and also abiding by provincially set class size and composition regulations. Many of the logistical factors

influencing class casting, such as final student numbers, staffing, and organization of divisions, are not yet finalized. Class casting remains tentative until into September when these factors are confirmed. Families are encouraged to trust school staff to place students in the best possible learning situation for all involved. Class placement decisions will be made by school staff with the best interests of all our learners as our goal.


2025-26 Quesnel School Fees

We have an exciting opportunity to share with you! Cycling BC, Cycling Canada, and MAPEI Canada are hosting the **MAPEI Build-to-Give Initiative** in Vancouver to get more kids on bikes and inspire them to ride by **giving away 45 brand new bicycles** (24" mountain bikes) to lower-income families in BC's Lower Mainland.

Families who want to receive a new bike must apply and meet My First Bicycle's Low Income Cut-off Guidelines¹⁷ to be eligible. Each family can get up to two bikes. Every bike will include a helmet, lock, bell and tools.
