#### Research Study Invitation for Adolescents and Parents

*Social media and Parent-Adolescent Communication: an Exploratory Study (SPACES)*

A research study is currently looking for parents of adolescents between the ages of 13 and 18 years old AND/OR adolescents between the ages of 13 and 18 years old to participate in a study about culture, social media and family communication!

This study aims to better understand the different cultural perspectives about how social media may impact the conversations between parents and adolescents.
