Social media and Parent-Adolescent Communication: an Exploratory Study (SPACES) A research study is currently looking for parents of adolescents between the ages of 13 and 18 years old AND/OR adolescents between the ages of 13 and 18 years old to participate in a study about culture, social media and family communication!




