### 2. PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE – Mr. Tony Romano

- Second Kindergarten class has been approved.
- May 2<sup>nd</sup> - Provincial Wide Earthquake Drill...Early Dismissal for some classes for practice...still up for discussion cause Tracey is on-holiday.
- Wednesday, April 24<sup>th</sup> starting at noon – Registration for Summer Learning
- May 8<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> for camp – grade 5 and 6 was canceled because lots of kids not wanting to go, number of families requiring financial aid...camps will only be for grade 7. Ms. Wallace is talking to Renfrew about possibly coordination to help with cost for next year. Tony will send out a letter to all parents.
- Sports Day is scheduled for May 17<sup>th</sup>. PAC will cover refreshments (Kathy to contact SaveOn Grandview to see about a donation again).
- Badminton is running until the end of April – Grade 6 and 7
- Track and Field will start in May – Grade 4 to 7
- Tap Dance Performance at Gladstone – April 24<sup>th</sup>
- Kindergarten Orientation – May 15<sup>th</sup>, 11AM - PAC banner set up, rep to attend if possible
- Trees – additional funds will be available after May 6<sup>th</sup>. Total for the tree is around \$2k. \$1k is required from PAC if possible - will check in with Jen W about TD Enviro grant option.

### 3. BUDGET REPORT - Rose Ngo

- GIC \$10,000 each : 1st May 6th, 2nd one matures Nov 4th. Earned approx \$300 per investment — Rose and Kathy signed new paperwork for GIC to be paid into the PAC general account upon maturity
- Scholarship Letter received : confirmed Gladstone \$500 - cheque issued this evening and to be delivered before April 12th directly to Gladstone by Kathy T
- Gaming Grant has been retroactively approved and \$4340 deposited directly into our gaming account on March 28th! - funds issued for Field Trips - cheque to Tony tonight
- DPAC cheque still waiting, Kathy emailed again and the Chair said they would be sending out soon
