#### Remembrance Day



On November 8<sup>th</sup>, we had a wonderful Remembrance Day Ceremony with students taking the lead in presenting the meaning of the day and in ways in which students can be peacemakers. Several classes participated in singing thoughtful songs on the theme of peace and in presenting poetry. It was nice to see several family members with us during the ceremony.

We collected \$232.00 in donations for the Vancouver Poppy Fund. This money will help ex-service men and women and their families by providing assistance for food, clothing, homes, furniture, transportation expenses.



Kindergarten registration for children born in 2020 began on November 1<sup>st</sup>. All kindergarten applicants are required to submit an application to their English catchment elementary school. This includes families who wish to apply for choice programs (Early French Immersion, Montessori, Indigenous Focus School, Early Mandarin Bilingual, Nootka Fine Arts) and/or make a cross-boundary application to attend a non-catchment school. The priority registration period for Kindergarten opens on November 1 and closes on January 31. Students who submit an application within this priority period will be accommodated before late applicants.

#### Applying for kindergarten is a **2-step process**:

#### Step 1: Online Application (ApplyNow)

Completion of an online application form
 (https://applynow.vsb.bc.ca/) for the school year 2025-2026.

#### Step 2: Verification of documentation

- Contact your English catchment school office to <u>set up an</u> <u>appointment</u> to bring your supporting documentation
- Bring supporting documentation to your English catchment school office during your scheduled appointment

#### Supporting documents needed:

- 1. Proof of residence in Vancouver
- 2. Child's birth certificate
- 3. Immigration documentation (if applicable)
- 4. Immunization records
- 5. Court orders/documents (if applicable)

#### Kindergarten Applications Received Between November 1 and January 31

- 1. **In-catchment** kindergarten applicants with siblings in attendance at the school (and who will be attending next year) will be placed first.
- 2. The names of all other in-catchment registrants will be entered into a random draw for the remaining kindergarten spaces.
- 3. Students who cannot be accommodated will be placed on a waitlist in the order in which their name was drawn.
- 4. Between January 31 and the second Friday in June students on the ordered waitlist will be accommodated as space becomes available.

#### Kindergarten Registrations Received AFTER January 31st

In-catchment kindergarten students who apply **after** January 31 will be accommodated if there is space. If there is no space, their names will be added to the bottom of the existing waitlist. **Note**: There will be **no priority** given to registrants with siblings if they register after January 31.

#### New Playground

The VSB is currently in the process of tendering the contract for the new intermediate playground to be built. In the new year, the Trudeau community will have the opportunity to help make the final decision.



- Current steps in place:
- 1) "Request for Proposals" (RFP) procurement process has begun
- 2) The designs will be evaluated by District staff to ensure they meet requirements/specifications
- 3) Two designs will be brought back to the school community through PAC for discussion/selection
- 4) Designs will focus on equipment and identified areas of surfacing required for accessibility
- 5) A timeline for completion will be set and communicated to the community
