Grade 10 Assembly and CLC 12 Course Selection

During FIT on Tuesday March 11th at 1:15 PM, all Grade 10 students are required to attend a mandatory assembly in the auditorium, where they will be given important information on CLC 12, Career Life Connections 12. CLC 12 is a course that is required for all students graduating in BC. Current Grade 10 Tupper students have the option of choosing to take CLC 12 in either their grade 11 year (2025/26 school year) or their grade 12 year (2026/27). Students are expected to take 8 courses plus CLC 12.

A CLC 12 Course Selection sheet will be given to current Grade 10 students. This sheet needs to be completed, signed, and returned to our Grade 10 counsellors by March 13th before 3:00 PM.

Grade 10 Provincial Assessments

Numeracy 10 and Literacy 10 Provincial Assessments are scheduled to take place from April 8th through 10th. Students that are currently in a Math 10 course or English 10 course are scheduled to write these assessments. There are some students currently not in these classes that are also scheduled to write. The assessment schedule has been posted on Tupper's Grade 10 and Grade 11 Teams, and the schedules are being posted outside of the library. These assessments are a graduation requirement.

How to access your student's report card on the MyEducation BC Family Portal

Mid-point reports will be found on the MyEducation BC Family Portal. Please follow the instructions below to locate your child's report:

1. Go to the MyEd Website (<https://www.myeducation.gov.bc.ca/aspn/logon.do>)
2. Type in the student number as the login ID
3. The password is the one that you and your student have already been using.
4. You will find the report card under "Published Reports" on the right-hand side.
5. **Please note** reports are deleted when new reports are generated. You may wish to save a copy for your records.

What if I forgot my password?

1. Click on the "I forgot my password" link.
2. A response should come to the email that is associated with the account.
3. If you do not recall the email associated with the account, please send an email tupper@vsb.bc.ca to request assistance.
