SpacesEDU for Core Competencies Student Self-Assessment

On June 19th, during FIT, our students will be completing their Final Core Competency Self-Assessment for the school year. This is a great opportunity to reflect on the school year, think about what went well, and to identify areas to work on next year. Tupper will once again be using the SpacesEDU platform to complete the assessment. **Plan Ahead.** If you have a mobile device, install SpacesEdu, found in the Apple IOS app store or the Google Android App Store. Devices will be made available for students that do not have a personal device of their own.

Graduating Students and Students Leaving VSB

Effective **July 1**, **Microsoft 365 login accounts** for graduating students and those leaving the Vancouver School Board (VSB) will no longer be operational. Students should ensure they transfer any OneDrive files to a personal account before this date. For added protection, all Microsoft data will be permanently deleted on **August 1, 2025**.

SpacesEDU allows users to retain login access by changing their email to a personal one through the account settings.

Canva accounts can also be converted into personal accounts by applying for conversion in the account settings. Once converted, data and account access will be released.

School Closing Items

Locker cleanout (June 23 and 24)

We will be asking that all students have their lockers completely emptied by 3:05 PM on June 24. Padlocks left on the locker will be cut off any time after June 25. Any unclaimed items will be removed and donated to charity.

Textbooks and Lost Items/Fees Owing

After June 20, 2025, students can pay for or return books directly to their teacher or in the office. Please advise students to make cheques payable to Sir Charles Tupper Secondary School when paying their lost or unreturned school items and ensure their student number is on the cheque as well.

Credit Capture – June 25 and June 26

The last day of regularly scheduled classes will be June 24. On June 25 and 26, students have the option to attend school and work on material or finish any missed assessment items. Teachers will be available to meet with students who attend their classes. The block order and timing will remain the same on both of those days, though students are able to stay in a class longer to finish assessment(s) if needed. Please make arrangements with the teacher if you will be coming in, as they might be elsewhere in the school during this time.

Semester 2 Reporting

Final reports for semester 2 will be posted to MyEducation BC on June 26th before 4:00 PM. Student progress is reported using cumulative assessment, which means that the grade a student receives always reflects the student's most recent and updated progress. Report cards will include a final course mark and anecdotal comment. Grade 10 to 12 courses will report student progress using percentages. Grade 8 & 9 student progress will be reported using a [Proficiency Scale](#).

How to access your student's report card on the MyEducation BC Family Portal

Final reports will be found on the MyEducation BC Family Portal. Please follow the instructions below to locate your child's report:

1. Go to the MyEd Website (<https://www.myeducation.gov.bc.ca/aspen/logon.do>)
2. Type in the student number as the login ID; the password is the one you have been sharing with your child.
3. You will find the report card under "Published Reports" on the right-hand side.
4. All MyEd BC Student Family accounts will be suspended by 11:59 PM August 8, 2025. This timeline is to accommodate students attending the summer learning program, allowing them to view/download their Learning Update upon course completion.
5. There is no access to your account or the published learning updates after August 8, 2025.
6. Students/parents should download, save and/or print a copy of the Learning Update for their records.
7. You can request a copy of your Learning Update from our office during summer hours.
*** Please call the school at 604-713-8233 to ensure our office staff is onsite before making a visit. ***
8. **All student accounts (returning and new) will be enabled by the end of the day, Friday, August 29, 2025, so that students can have access on the first day of school – September 2, 2025. Accounts will be accessible by your last successful login ID and password credentials.**

Information will be sent out and posted on our website in August, in preparation for the start of the new school year. Please watch out for it. Students requiring course changes should contact their grade counselor via Teams or e-mail to schedule an appointment during the week of August 25th.
