





Tupper - Blue Tray Pilot Project:

Food services will be running a pilot project for the remainder of the school year and will be using the Blue Trays to serve food. Tupper contributes 21,000 paper plates per year and the goal is to reduce the amount of waste that we generate. We ask all staff and students who use these trays (or see them laying around) to return them to their allocated collection bins stationed in the cafeteria. Collectively, let's work together to reduce our environmental footprint and build a more sustainable school community.


Tupper is Reducing Waste
