- Program runs at Sir Charles Tupper Secondary during Semester 1
- Students receive hands-on experience in two main areas:
 - Residential Construction (Carpentry, Plumbing, Tiling and Finishing)
 - Mechanical Repair (Welding, Automotive, Sheet Metal and Machine work)
- Students are prepared to transition into a post-secondary program or an apprenticeship, sometimes before high school graduation
