Tuesday and Thursday FIT:

Tuesday: Students will stay in their 2-4 class for FIT. Students in grade 10 and 12, will complete the student learning survey during FIT. To minimize disruptions to this process, we ask that students in grade 8, 9, and 11 also stay in their classes and work independently.

Thursday: This FIT block will be shortened and will run from 1:15 – 1:45pm. Students will then have a break and must be in their 2-3 class by 1:55. This will allow students to participate in the earthquake drill with their last block teacher. Students will stay in their 2-4 class (class immediately after lunch) and complete their self-assessment of the Core Competencies and upload to spaces.edu.

For both FIT blocks (Tuesday and Thursday), students should bring extra work or a book to read as they will not leave the classroom during this time.

- 1. Go to the MyEd Family Portal Website
- 2. Type in the student number as the login ID
- 3. The password is the one that you and your child have already been using
- 4. You will find the MOST UPDATE report card under "Published Reports" on the right-hand side
- 5. Please note report cards are deleted when new reports are generated. You may wish to save a copy for your records.
