#### **2. PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE – Mr. Tony Romano (20 min)**

- Spring fair was a success, thank you to everyone involved
- Sports day was cloudy, perfect weather, also a success
- Track and field, over 60 students involved, compete with other elementary schools
- School choir did their final performance, thank you to Miss Ania
- Moving into the last few weeks of June, working on the learning updates from the teachers, we will receive an email from the my space ed account
- iPads are ordered, thank you to all the parents for their fundraising efforts. Should be ready for september
- Wish list: to have some covers to protect the ipad. Could the PAC help with this?
- Medals for grade 7?
- Movie night: talked to another school (Nootka) that they switched to right after school instead of evening, they are having a huge turnaround, and they will continue with this time slot
- Ms. Morani is surplus and might not be back in September. There was not enough enrolment for kindergarten to have two classes. 44 schools are losing approx. 400 students, we would need 10 more K students to have another class.
- SSA support, should keep what we have this year. Around 5 SSA.
- Configuration will be sent later in the fall, first PAC in September, once everything is settled.
- 23 grade 7 for the new school year, it is down as well.

-Fundraising this year: we exceeded our role: \$14,130.25 (hot lunch not included in here). We didn't do any hot chocolate sales this year.

#### **8. SPRING FAIR ~ FRIDAY JUNE 5TH ~ Overview (15 min)**

- **SURVEY MONKEY REVIEW:** Tracy has access to 6 out of 25 responses (would need to pay to have full access).
- What did they like: Cotton candy, plinko, water tank, games and prizes, glitter tattoos, magician, balloon artist (but hard to hear the magician)
- What they could do without: beef burger (need to be careful about the cooking), inside games, too many activities that cost money, need for new games, tickets for the games to be used for the food.
- What they would like to see for next year: tickets to be exchanged for prizes, or have a table with gently used toys, or have treats instead of toys. Dunk tank (but we are doing water tank). Soccer or sports (would need volunteers). More food and drink options. Cash and credit payment separated. Cake walk? Silent auction, crowded halls, hallway too crowded upstairs
- Next year propositions:
  - Put upfront the outcome of the fundraising from the spring fair and what we did with the money. Or show live the amount that was raised at the spring fair.
  - Next year: Have the lines for the food and for the games tickets away from each other, this year they were too close, they were crossing each other and it was confusing.

#### **9. MUNCH A LUNCH PROGRAM WRAP UP**

- New this year, but huge success, thank you to Rylie and Cristina for all their hard work!
- Credit at the end of the school year, needs to be at zero: can carry over to the next school year if the students are coming back. If not coming back they can give their funds to the PAC. Or they can also ask for a refund.
- \$4,830.95 in profit
- Vendors: over time there were decreasing Subway orders, increasing Uncle Fatih's orders, Domino's orders are stable. Boston pizza, they were new to hot lunch but quality and flavours have improved and interest as well.
