

SACY Family Stream

An opportunity for parents and caregivers to learn about teen substance use and build tools for prevention.



Description

Building Bridges is a **90-minute** interactive **workshop** facilitated by the Family Stream of SACY (Supporting and Connecting Youth), offering parents and caregivers an opportunity to learn about teen substance use and build tools for prevention.
