The 2026 [Neighbourhood Small Grants \(NSG\)](#) applications open on **March 30, 2026**. Youth aged 12-24 can apply for a [Y-NSG](#) grant up to \$500, to fund projects that connect people socially or promote skill sharing with each other. Once you have applied for a grant and your project has been approved, you do not need to pay the money back. There are also NSG (for adults), Indigenous NSG (I-NSG), and Greenest City Grants (GCG).
