

DT Counselling Team

- 4 Counsellors at David Thompson, Grade 8's are divided among 4 via last names
- Counsellors are on-site every school day; they are not shared with other schools
- Secondary school Counsellors can support students with:

 - Course Planning – Selection/Timetabling/Graduation Planning
 - Social/Emotional Support – Interpersonal issues/Mental Health
 - Career Planning – Post Secondary Info/Finding good career fits
 - Communication – Facilitating communication with teachers, parents and other professionals
 - Referrals – external agencies for additional support

 - Technical/Media Studies



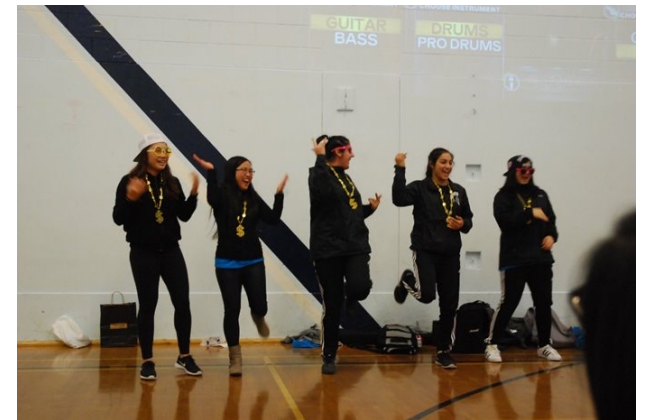
Fine Arts 8 Rotation or Band

Flexible Instruction Time (FIT)

- **Purpose:** to support the learning and well-being of students by enabling them to have choice in how, when, and where their learning takes place.
- **Expectations:** Students are in a learning space.
- **Examples:** meeting with teachers for extra help, attending tutorial session, connecting with a counsellor, collaborating with others on projects, core competency reflection and goal setting.



Registering for David Thompson

- Grade 7 Teacher will distribute **Verification and Course Selection Form** (blue)
- Please follow elementary school's deadlines – complete and return the form to elementary school.
- ALL forms must be sent by the elementary schools to DT by the week of February 2, 2026.
- All registrations **must include proof of address**. Please attach copies to your registration form.

Section 2: Documentation Required – please attach current copies of the following documents.

Proof of Address by Custodial Parent or Legal Guardian is required to verify secondary school catchment.

One of:

- ☐ Long-term Tenancy agreement - showing legal name and address.
- ☐ Property purchase agreement - showing legal name and address.
- ☐ Property tax statement - showing legal name and address.

Cross Boundary Applications

- Students in the Vancouver School District are allowed to register at a school outside of their catchment area as a cross-boundary applicant.
- Cross boundary applications will **only be considered after all in-catchment students have been accommodated.**
