January Ministry Assessment Schedule

This is a reminder of the ministry assessment schedule for January 2025. The schedule is as follows:

Mon. Jan. 12 & Fri. Jan. 16- LTF 12 (French Immersion)

Tues. Jan. 13- LTE 12 (ALL Gr. 12s) *no Gr. 12 classes in session on this day (except IB)*

Weds. Jan. 14- LTE 10 (ALL Gr. 10s & 11/12s who've not yet written) *no Gr. 10 classes in session on this day*

Thurs. Jan. 16- NME 10 (11/12s who've not yet written)

Student lists will be posted to the All Students Team as well as the Gr. 10-12 teams before winter break. Students should review the lists to determine if/when and where they will be writing their assessments.

Students must come with ID (GO card, etc.) and their PEN (listed at the top of learning updates) to write.

AM assessments begin at 8:30. PM assessments begin at 12:15pm. Students must be on time or will not be able to write until a future session.

Core Competency Self-Assessment

Students have recently completed a self-assessment of their personal learning goals as part of the BC Ministry of Education's Core Competency framework. Parents and caregivers may have received an email from the school district with instructions on how to view their child's progress in SpacesEDU.

There are no required actions at this time, but we encourage you to take this opportunity to talk with your child about their goals for the year and the strategies they're using to achieve them.

Our next Core Competency session will take place during FIT on **February 10**. During this session, students will focus on gathering evidence that demonstrates how they are working toward their goals.

Building Bridges from SACY

Building Bridges is a 90-minute interactive workshop facilitated by the Family Stream of SACY (Supporting and Connecting Youth), offering parents and caregivers an opportunity to learn about teen substance abuse and build tools for prevention.

At this workshop, parents and caregivers will explore topics such as destigmatizing substances, prevention and safety, and how to have conversations with teens about substances.
