## IE Days & Semester 1 Final Reports

**IE Days are Mon, Jan. 26 & Tues, Jan. 27.** On these days, your child may be asked by specific teachers to come in to receive additional support, complete outstanding work, and/or demonstrate skills required for success in the course. If requested by teachers, students are expected to attend. **If not requested by teachers, students are not required to be at school.** Teachers will be informing students and parents about IE Day attendance by January 23, 2026.

Now is a good time to review grades in general ahead of the end of semester, and to encourage your child to **sign up for FIT for one-on-one support.** FIT bookings are made through our [VSB FIT Planner website](#), and parents can check sign up by asking their child to log in and show them their bookings. The password is the same as the one they use to access Office 365 and school wifi.

The first day of Semester 2 is Wednesday, January 28.

Semester 1 Final Reports and Linear mid-year reports will be published in MyEd at 2pm on Friday, January 30.

## Course Planning

We have started to plan for the next school year. Students have begun meeting with their grade counsellors to review course planning procedures. Thank you to those families who were able to attend our course planning event on January 8<sup>th</sup>. We hope you found the information useful.

Course selection is integral to building our 2026-2027 timetable and will guide us in creating a schedule that meets the needs and goals of our students. All students will be expected to select their courses in their MyED BC account by **February 20, 2026**. Please ensure your child can access their account. If your child is unable to log in, they must contact the main office for assistance.

Course selection should be planned thoughtfully, based on student interests and educational goals. ## Pick Up, Drop Off, Staff Parking Lot

To help keep our school community safe, we're asking all parents and caregivers to **avoid using the staff parking lot for student drop-off or pick-up at all times**. This area is **reserved for VSB staff only**; additional vehicles create safety concerns and block access for staff.

Please also use extra care when dropping off or picking up students on Heather St. before/after school. Please drive slowly, park carefully, and stay alert to students crossing. Thank you for supporting a smooth and safe start and end to each school day.

## Core Competency Self-Assessment

As part of the Ministry of Education's mandate, all students must complete a self-assessment of their Core Competencies (communication, thinking, and personal/social responsibility). These reflections must be submitted through SpacesEDU.

In November, students set a personal goal connected to the Core Competencies that they will work on throughout the year. The next step is gathering evidence that demonstrates their progress toward this goal.

During FIT on February 10, students will participate in a short lesson focused on how to collect and select meaningful evidence. In March, they will upload their evidence to SpacesEDU as part of their ongoing learning portfolio.

## Digital Devices in Classes

We continue our work to align with ministry and district policies on digital device use in schools, as we know this is critical to support student engagement and learning in the classroom.

**Classrooms are a digital device-free zone**, and personal digital devices must be turned off or placed in silent mode **and** stored in backpacks/bags before entering the classroom. These devices are not permitted for use (pictures, recordings, messaging, calls, social media, games, music, etc.) during instructional time unless an educator has given permission. Staff are enforcing this policy within the context of their classrooms in a variety of ways. As necessary, teachers and administrators may contact parents directly regarding a student's phone use and discuss strategies to support student success in this area.
