Scholarships

Core Competency Self-Reflection

Next Tuesday, April 7th and Friday, April 10th, students will be staying with their Period 1 teacher for their FIT class. During FIT, teachers will go over the self-reflection process with students. Students will receive a hardcopy [assignment sheet](#) that they will need to fill out using the Core Competency **'I Statements.'** By Friday's FIT class, students will need to upload their assignment sheet to their SpacesEDU account. A link to the student submission will be shared with parents/guardians at a later date so they can see their child's reflection.

As a reminder, all students in British Columbia need to complete 3 self-reflections on the Core Competencies every year. Core Competencies are the foundation of the BC Curriculum, and are considered essential lifelong skills that support deep learning. These Core Competencies are woven through every subject area, and the process of reflecting on them helps students to understand **how** they learn, and not just **what** they learn.
