BCIT is offering two new health sciences preparation courses for current high school students, starting July 2026.

Healthcare Horizons is an online microcredential course for students in grades 10-12 who want to explore the world of healthcare. Learners will gain an understanding of Canada's healthcare system and the wide range of professionals who make it function effectively. With an optional one day on campus in person experience, this course helps students learn what kind of health career paths might suit them best.
