Notice of Late Return

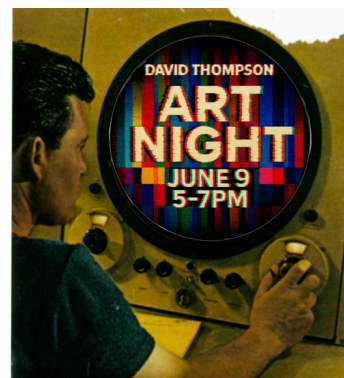
