Dear Parent/Guardian of New Kindergarten Students:

Welcome to Tyee! We would like to let you know about our plan for school opening.

To help your child have a successful start to the Full Day Kindergarten Program we have a gradual entry schedule for the first 5 days of attendance in September. Gradual entry provides the opportunity for your child to begin to bond with their teacher and become comfortable in their school by interacting with students in a smaller group for a shorter period.

Kindergarten students will begin attending school on Wednesday, September 9th, 2026.

Students have been divided into 2 groups (Group A and Group B). Your child will be in **Group A**. Please see the schedule below outlining the Group B schedule.

You and your child are invited to meet individually with the kindergarten teacher.
