Important Reminders

- 1) The first day is only 1 hour – from 9 am to 10 am for Gr 1-7.
- 2) Kindergarteners attend 9:15 to 9:45 am on Tuesday and then follow their gradual entry schedule.
- 3) Starting on Wednesday, send a water bottle, recess snack and lunch with your child.
- 4) **Starting on Wednesday, the regular school day for 2026/2027 starts at 9 am and ends at 3:00 pm!**
- 5) The **September package of notices** will soon be sent home with your child. Thank you for taking the time to sign, update all the documents and return the paper forms to your child's teacher. Note that once again the VSB is using the MyForms application to capture all online consents. Lastly, please note that all payments are only accepted through SchoolCashOnline.

Attendance

If your child will be away or late, please report your child's absence, please call our **Safe Arrival line 604-713-5159 # 14** or email us at brkattendance@vsb.bc.ca before 9 AM.

Signing Students In and Out – If your child has an appointment and or arrives late from an appointment etc., please follow the protocols below:

- 1) Email the office at brkattendance@vsb.bc.ca and the teacher. Include your child's first and last name & division and details of absences with pick-up and/or drop-off times.
- 2) Once you arrive at school, check in with the office by dropping into the office or calling 604-713-5245. Any pick-ups or drop-offs will take place in the undercover area.
- 3) If you need to drop off something your child forgot at home, you are welcome to go straight to your child's classroom, knock and drop it off.

Before and After School Supervision

Students are welcome to arrive between 8:45 and 8:58 AM. The 8:45 AM bell signifies the start of morning staff supervision. When they hear the 8:58 bell, students are expected to be lined up and ready for their teachers to lead them into the building. After the **3:00 PM** dismissal bell, there will be one last bell at 3:15 PM to signify the end of afternoon staff supervision. Unless in a specific program, all students should be heading home by 3:15 PM.

We are happy to announce that our librarian is once again going to **open our Library on Tuesdays to Friday from 8:45 to 8:58 AM** for student book exchange.
