GRADUATION ASSESSMENT INFORMATION

Graduation assessments are used to assess students' proficiency in numeracy and literacy. Graduation assessments are not associated with any course mark, but their completion is part of the BC Graduation Requirements.

Students in Grade 10 have been scheduled to write the numeracy assessment on **Friday November 3, 2023**. We will also run a make- up session for any student in grade 11 or 12 who has not written the numeracy 10 assessment.

LEARNING UPDATES (STUDENT REPORTING)

Students have received an **electronic** Interim Learning Update published to their <u>MyEducationBC</u> account on October 13 and will be available online until November 20. Mid-Semester Learning Updates will be published on November 24. It is recommended that you download and save a copy for future reference.

If your child receives an IE (Insufficient Evidence) for any of their classes, it is crucial that they connect with their teacher(s) to develop a plan to demonstrate their learning of the course material. Please note that all work must be submitted prior to the end of the semester to be assessed and evaluated for semester 1 Summary of Learning unless specified by the teacher.

The end of the semester is the end of the course and teachers are unable to accept and assess work after the semester ends. If you have any questions about your child's progress, you are welcome to email the teacher or grade counsellor directly. Click <u>HERE</u> for our staff directory.

Note that the final written summative report also includes the requirement for a student self-assessment of the Core Competencies (Communication, Thinking, and Personal and Social). Once a month, PW



students will meet with their Homeroom teachers during FIT to work on their self- assessments. Students are expected to attend these sessions and make-up sessions will be made available during FIT with administration.


Forms

We have received many forms into the office, however there are still some that are outstanding. Ms. Landers will be connecting with families directly over the next few weeks to make sure we get all the forms from every family. In addition to the paper forms, there are also several digital forms that need to be filled out. To update your child's VSB consent forms online, please visit https://myforms.vsb.bc.ca with your child, so you can each fill out the appropriate forms.

- Enter student PEN and birthdate.
- Accept the consent for each of the forms. Not accepting or completing implies decline.
- Once consent is given, a REVOKE button is exposed.

Fees

To pay school or course fee, create an account using <u>School Cash Online</u>. The school fee schedule (an itemized list of fees to be paid by grade), can be found <u>HERE</u>. **Please pay ASAP as the due date** was **Sept 29**. Any future fees, for events such as field trips, will be available on School Cash Online.

CAREER PROGRAMS

Mark Reid, District Resource Teacher at VSB Career Programs, is coming to deliver a presentation for all Gr. 10s 11s and 12's on November 28th, 2023 during FIT (1:22-2:02 pm). Career Programs supports students with transitions to various careers in Skilled Trades or training to become a Healthcare Assistant or Early Childhood Educator. Students in grade 12 can also benefit from partnerships that allow students to start paid skilled trades apprenticeships during grade 12.

This event is at Charles Tupper Secondary at 6:30pm. Various employers and industry representatives will be there and will take your questions about apprenticeship, training, Women in Trades, and supports for youth pursuing a skilled trade.

SCHOOL PHOTOS

If you ordered school photos, they will be handed out during homeroom on Thursday Oct 19.

Retakes: If you aren't happy with your photo or missed photo day, you can have a photo taken on Retake Day October 30, 2023 in the Mini Gym.

Artona will prioritize photos for students who were absent on photo day. Retakes will only be allowed when they can improve their photography, e.g., eyeglass glare, poor posture, too much head tilt, eyes closed. There will be no retakes for grade 12s as their grad photo will be used for the composite. Students who require a retake must bring their ID card to hand into the photographer.

GRADE 9 IMMUNICATION CLINIC
