The purpose of this newsletter is to inform students and parents/guardians of the important information regarding the Graduation events including: Graduation School Leaving Ceremony and Dinner/Dance in June. Can you believe it... Grad 2024 is rapidly approaching! It is incredible how quickly the years have passed. We know this is the moment you have been waiting for since kindergarten graduation, and the moment your children have been working towards so diligently all these years. Every year, the staff of Prince of Wales Secondary sponsors a graduation ceremony and this year, the school has sanctioned the dinner-dance to celebrate the culmination of our students' high school studies. This letter aims to congratulate you as parents and caregivers and provide you with dates, details, and an early estimate of any costs involved with graduation celebrations.

<u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> These are school-sponsored events. Therefore, all VSB and school rules and policies apply. If it is suspected that any student has consumed <u>any</u> drugs or alcohol before any of our graduation events, they will not be allowed access.

GRADUATION CEREMONY- DETAILS

The staff of Prince of Wales Secondary have traditionally held this celebration for those students who attend regularly and who are achieving success in the courses required for graduation.

Graduation (Commencement) Ceremony Schedule Thursday, June 20th – 1:30 pm (please be on time) Chan Centre - 6265 Crescent Road, University of British Columbia

8:30 - 10:00 am Grad Rehearsal at the Chan Centre - GRADS ONLY

12:30 pm Students return to Chan Centre, please allow time for parking. Students

MUST be on time! At this time, the Chan Centre lobby will open.

1:00 pm Doors open for <u>general seating</u>—tickets must be presented at the door.

1:30 pm Graduation Ceremony begins promptly at 1:30 pm.

As this is a formal occasion, we expect everyone to be on their very best behaviour. Applause is appreciated; whistling and shouting are not. Please turn off your cellular phones/any electronic devices before you enter the theatre. Grads are to remain seated in their reserved seats throughout the ceremony. Families and guests are asked to remain seated until the ceremony and the formal recessional from the theatre are complete - this allows all parents and guests to see their graduates. Artona Studios will take a picture of each graduate as they cross the stage, and these pictures are mailed home in August to the grads.

The UBC Rose Gardens are available for PW use before and after the ceremony. However, gowns and sashes are rented and thus will be dropped off immediately after the ceremony. As such, please take all the pictures you want in gowns before the ceremony.

VALEDICTORIAN SELECTION: The Valedictorian is chosen by the Graduating Class to present the farewell address to parents, fellow students and staff, at the Graduation Ceremonies on June 20.

Nomination forms will be posted to students in April in the PW Student Hub, and are due May 6th. Valedictorian speeches and voting selection will take place in FIT (1:22-2:02 pm) on Tuesday May 21, 2024 in the auditorium.

GOWNS FOR GRAD CEREMONY: The grads will receive their gowns/stolls/hats as well as all complimentary and purchased tickets in their assembly in FIT (1:22-2:02 pm) Tuesday June 11th in the auditorium. Please make sure your child notes the day and time of the assembly.

GRAD CEREMONY REHEARSAL: Two rehearsals are planned for all grads. The first is an overview in our auditorium on Tuesday June 11th during FIT and a full rehearsal will be held on Thursday June 20th, from 8:30-10:00 am at the Chan Centre. It is mandatory that all grads attend these events.

<u>GRADUATION CEREMONY MESSAGE:</u> Each Graduate is responsible for drafting a SHORT message that will be read as they cross the stage. Some examples of what you may want to include are: "What you will fondly remember, your future plans; Regards to people you may wish to thank; A reflective statement of some kind."

Remember that this will be read by a teacher/administrator, so it must be written in the third person (e.g. Emily is excited to be taking a year off in the fall and travelling around the world. She will miss her friends and family in Vancouver. Your message must be appropriate for a formal occasion, and it must be 30-50 words long maximum and be submitted electronically using the form: <u>HERE.</u> The ceremony messages are due on **Monday May 6th**, **2024 by 4:00 pm**.

<u>TICKETS FOR GRAD CEREMONY</u>: Each graduate will receive two complimentary tickets (students do not need a ticket, student and two for the student's guests). There are a limited number of additional tickets available. Families can purchase up to 10 additional tickets for \$10.00 each starting April 15th until June 3rd on school cash online (https://vsb.schoolcashonline.com/). Students will receive additional purchased tickets with their gown and complimentary tickets at the FIT assembly on June 11th. If you require more than the 10 additional tickets, more tickets (if available) can be purchased in the school office on June 12th- 14th.


NO TICKETS WILL BE SOLD AT THE CHAN CENTRE ON THE DAY OF THE CEREMONY.

GRAD FEE: A grad fee of \$80 has been added to each graduate's account on <u>SchoolCashOnline</u>, this covers all the costs involved with the graduation ceremony. All student accounts must be settled for students to participate in Graduation events. Reminders from accounting and the library for outstanding owed items will be sent out next week.

Students attending PW Prom will need to sign up for table groups as **groups of 8** by May 13. All group members will need to have paid for their prom ticket before the submission.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS- CLC & CAPSTONE, GRADUATION ASSESSMENTS

<u>CLC & CAPSTONE:</u> All grade 12 students will create a Capstone Project as part of their graduation requirements in their Career Life Connection 12 (CLC) Class. A Capstone is a multi-faceted project that encourages both research and experience as part of the student's exploration. Students have spent more than 30 hours delving into their interests, passions and possible future paths in these culminating projects and shared the story of these explorations in their Capstone. These Capstone projects might explore something the student is passionate about, an area that interests them deeply, or is the student's attempt to answer, "Who am I, and what is the best path for me in the future?" Note: if a student does not complete CLC& Capstone, they will not graduate.

<u>GRADUATION ASSESSMENTS:</u> Students are required to write the Literacy 10, Numeracy 10 and Literary 12 assessments for graduation. Most students have completed these requirements. Please check with your counsellor if you are unsure.

Grade 12 students who have not completed any of the Numeracy 10, Literacy 10 Assessment or Grade 12 students who have not completed the Literacy 12 Assessment will have another opportunity on **Friday April 19, 2024 8:30-11:40 am in the library** to meet this graduation requirement. Your counsellor will contact you with a reminder, time, and room number.

For students who wrote the Literacy 12 assessment in January 2023, results should be posted. If a grade 12 student would like to rewrite their Literacy 12 assessment, there will be an opportunity on Friday April 19, 2023—please contact Mr. Tse.

For students who want to access their assessment results and a personalized performance report, go to <u>Student Transcripts Service</u> website and register for a BCeID. Once you have created an account to access the site, click on "Graduation Assessment/Provincial Exam Results" to view the results. Note, this site is where you can also "View Your Transcript," "Send/Order Your Transcript" as well as other options. The Ministry transcript contains only your completed courses, not in-progress courses.

SUMMER MAILOUT: The Ministry of Education Dogwood Diploma will be mailed home at the end of August, if the graduation requirements are met. If you have recently moved or will be moving at the end of the school year, please remember to inform the office. This will ensure that you receive this document from Prince of Wales Secondary School.

May 9, 2024: MADD Presentation, "Final Play", FIT EXTENDED (1:10 PM- 2:15 PM), Auditorium

MADD Canada's School Programs bring high-energy drug and alcohol impaired driving awareness and risk reduction messaging to the world of education. Youth and school programming have been a key component of MADD Canada's youth services, education and awareness initiatives since 1994. The programs are designed to communicate directly with young people on their level and in their language and encourage them to take a closer look at their values and perceptions.
