Class Placements for 2024-2025 and Monday Transition for Grade 1-7 students:

We are happy to confirm that we have received the go ahead to transition to our new classes for this 2024-2025 school year. On Friday afternoon, families will be receiving an email from the school indicating their child's new classroom teacher, division and where the pickup/drop off spot is.

Please have your child line up at their new class pickup spot on Monday morning when the bell goes. Teachers will come out to greet students and bring them inside the building.

Please know that the staff (classroom teachers, resource teachers and support staff) as well as administration were very involved in the process of class placements for this year. Much discussion and deliberation was put into the thoughtful placement of students. Staff worked to ensure classes were balanced to ensure equity and considered student academic level, social-emotional needs and other learning needs. If you have concerns about your child's learning that you would like to communicate with the new classroom teacher, please feel free to connect with that teacher at a later date.

Safe Arrival and leaving early:

If your child will be away from school, please be sure to **call or email the school** to let us know. Children who are not reported as absent on the safe arrival line/email will receive a phone call from our office staff to ensure their safety. If your child is **arriving late**, they must **sign in at the office** before heading to class.

If a **student** is **leaving school early**, parents - please present yourself at the office to sign the student out. We will call the student down to the office. Thank you for your cooperation with this important safety measure.

Play Spaces & Student Safety

This week at L'École Bilingue we have been working hard to implement some strategies to keep all of our students safe. Teachers thought it best to have a dedicated play area for our kindergarten/grade one learners so as to avoid any collisions with bigger students. The interim decision was made to have the back playground and back basketball area as dedicated kindergarten/grade one play spaces. Grade 2 students are invited to play in the front of the school, gravel field and as well enjoy the back area of the school where the garden and blacktop hopscotch area is located. Grade 3-7 students are invited to play on the front playground structure, basketball court and gravel field. We will be purchasing more sports equipment for students to play with at recess/lunch time in order to help with engagement at these outside break times. These play space boundaries are in place in the interim and staff will continue to evaluate how things are going.

Weather

It has been a lovely week with the sun shining, making it ideal for outdoor play. However, since we do live in 'Raincouver' the rain will certainly come. Please be reminded that students will go outside to play on all school days unless there is severe weather or a safety issue. Please ensure that you help equip your child for the weather.

Parking Lot

Please be reminded that the school parking lot located at the corner of Alder and 14th is for staff use only during school hours. Parents may park on the street to escort their children to their pick up/drop off spot. Additionally, please be reminded not to use the parking lot as a pathway to and from the school as it can be dangerous if there are cars coming and going.

Playground/Grounds Supervision

Playground/grounds supervision is from 8:40-9:00am and 2:58-3:18pm. Staff will be outside providing supervision at these times. Please do not drop off your child before 8:40am as there will be no supervision. Also, please pick up your child close to the dismissal time and before 3:18pm as supervision of the grounds does ends at that time. Thank you for your cooperation.

Medication

If your child is prescribed a medication that has to be delivered during the school day (EpiPen, puffer, etc.) please be sure to come by the office to discuss with Mme Christine, our office staff and first aid attendant. There is a consent form that we require filled in order to help with the administration of medication.

Cell Phones & Personal Devices

Following the provincial government's new orders regarding cell phone and personal devices (please see link below for more information), students will not be permitted to use their cell phones during the school day. If parents wish for their child to have a cell phone/device, students must tuck their cell phone/device away in their backpack before school starts and it must remain tucked away for the duration of the day. 
FALL SHOW! SCOOBY DOO!


