- 1. **Extreme Weather and School Closures**: Please check the information below regarding extreme weather conditions and potential school closures.
- 2. Traffic Safety:
  - Follow traffic regulations during morning drop-off and afternoon pick-up.
  - For families commuting from various parts of the city, we encourage you to park your vehicles and safely escort your children across the street and onto the school grounds.
  - If dropping off older students, ensure you drop them off on the proper side of the street and park your vehicle instead of letting them out mid-street. 14th Avenue is busy with bikes and other vehicle traffic.
  - Morning supervision begins at 8:40 AM, and students are welcome to come onto the grounds to play and connect before the 9:00 AM start time.
  - Consider parking a few blocks away and walking to school together to get some exercise and set a positive tone for the day.

In the coming months, we look forward to having Constable Christie from the VPD traffic department and community policing support our school safety. We also hope to implement a student patrol program next year.
