Welcome Back L'École Bilingue Families,

We hope that you had a wonderful summer break and are feeling rested and excited for the 2025/26 school year ahead.

This year we welcome a cohort of new grade one students to the French Immersion program. As well we welcome about twenty new grade two to seven students to our community of learners. This week has been all about seeing/meeting friends, reconnecting and getting back into the school groove.

We are pleased to welcome several new staff members to the L'École Bilingue family:

We continue to work towards filling three positions – Grade six, Kindergarten and a part-time Prep/Resource position. As you may be well-aware, finding suitable and qualified teachers, especially for French Immersion is a challenge. We continue to work on this and will keep these impacted students/families updated with timely and relevant information as needed.

This week students spent time with their classmates and classroom teacher from last year. Time playing and sharing about their summer experiences, slowly getting back into routines. On Monday we have been approved to move into our new class placements for the 2025/26 school year and on families will receive an email with specifics about their child's new teacher, classroom location, and dismissal/pick up location. Please look for this email.

This is a very exciting time for students, and we want to assure families that teachers used their careful professional judgement in figuring out class placements and there were many factors to consider during this process. In all cases, teachers made their best efforts to

ensure that the placement was done to ensure student success and to ensure that there was at least one preferred friend in the same class. This time of year brings excitement but also big feelings of anxiety, with some students worrying about their friends and new teacher. As a parent/family you can help to encourage your child to have a growth mindset, to try and see the positives about the placement and to encourage them to put forward their best attitude. With time we find all our students settle into their new classes and work towards a positive and productive year of learning.

If you have specific concerns about your learner and would like to communicate that with the classroom teacher, especially if there are specific safety and learning concerns/ needs, please do reach out.

We will have our 'Meet the teacher' night on Thursday September 18<sup>th</sup> and that will align with our evening 'Welcome Back BBQ' event which is hosted by the PAC. If you haven't already, please mark this evening on your calendar and join us to meet the teacher and then for the barbeque to connect with other LEB families.

Our school newsletters will be sent out on a bi-weekly basis typically on Fridays. In these newsletters are important/relevant information and reminders from the administrative team. Also, you will find important information about dates (pro-d, information nights, school spirit days). As well the PAC embeds in our newsletter information about after-school programming which may interest you.

## **Safe Arrival**
