

November 1st is Musqueam Day—a day the Musqueam celebrate the strength and determination of their ancestors who sought justice and the protection of their inherent rights. The day recognizes the landmark 1984 Supreme Court of Canada *Guerin decision*, led by Musqueam's then chief, Delbert Guerin. The case fundamentally changed Canadian law by affirming the legal enforceability of the Crown's obligations to First Nations, which includes a fiduciary duty, the nature of Aboriginal title, and the Crown's duty to consult. 


