

## **Reading One-to-One Parent Workshop**

We were very fortunate to have Catherine Evashuk share some great simple ways to teach students to love reading! On Thursday, November 27<sup>th</sup> she led a parent workshop in our school library. The library was filled with primary parents who were eventually joined by one of their children, so they had an opportunity to practice the new strategies they learned. One was called "The 3 P's". You can use this strategy when reading with your child and they stop, because they don't know the word.

Instead of telling them the word, **Pause** and count to 5 to give them time to figure it out on their own. If they don't, **Prompt** them. When they get it **Praise** them! Simple but effective. At the end, each parent was awarded a goody bag of literacy games. It was very well received, and we were grateful to Reading **One-to-One Literacy Society**, who are a registered BC charitable organization. Thank you to the PAC for providing donuts and coffee, also well received!

















