THE AFREEN AHMED MEMORIAL PRIZE

Afreen Ahmed, who passed away on January 25, 2019, was an incredible mother to a David Thompson student who graduated in 2010. She was an integral part of not only her daughter's ability to persevere to achieve a rewarding professional career despite challenging times, but also a regular fixture in the school's halls and in other students' lives. Afreen Ahmed was a schoolteacher in Pakistan and when she immigrated to Canada she became a childcare giver, raising and enriching the lives of many children for over 20 years, She was an open-minded, resilient, and determined woman and a loving and encouraging mother.

Afreen's daughter has established an annual award of \$2000 in her mother's memory to be given to a female-identifying Grade 12 student who is entering post-secondary studies despite financial, physical, and/or personal barriers.

Eligibility Criteria

- Female-identifying student of David Thompson Secondary in Grade 12;
- Obtained entrance into a recognized post-secondary institution, college, or university;
- One or more of the following:
 - Overcome or currently facing personal or family adversity;
 - o Demonstrated financial need; or
 - Overcome or currently facing physical or health barriers;
- One or more of the following:
 - Excelled academically, especially in the face of personal, family, financial, or physical adversity; or
 - Had significant volunteer involvement, especially in the face of personal, family, financial, or physical adversity;

Application Requirements

- Complete the attached application form;
- Complete graduate requirements by June 30, 2022;
- Any post-secondary admission documentation;
- Write a personal statement of a maximum of 1500 words demonstrating that the above eligibility criteria are met and outlining the student's post-secondary plans and any financial need;
- Report cards or transcripts of grades;
- Up to 2 letters of reference from teachers, volunteering, or other community members
