

DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY FOR THE PROTECTION OF STUDENTS

Background

Authority shall be delegated to principals, vice-principals, all teachers, all custodians, all maintenance staff, all clerical staff and all supervisory staff in the employ of the District and to Police School Liaison Officers to make such directions and to follow such courses of action as deemed appropriate for the protection of students, and to direct persons to leave the land or premises of a school.

This Administrative Procedure constitutes authorization pursuant to the School Act.

Procedures

1. The order of authority under this authorization is as follows:
 - 1.1 Principal, and in the event of the Principal's absence, or delegation, a
 - 1.2 Vice-Principal or Police School Liaison Officer, and in the event of the Vice-Principal's or Liaison Officer's absence, or delegation, a
 - 1.3 Teacher, and in the event of the teacher's absence, or delegation, a
 - 1.4 Member of the supervisory staff of the District, and in the event of the District supervisory staff's absence, or delegation, a
 - 1.5 Custodian, maintenance staff member, or clerical staff member.
 - 1.6 A Maintenance Order pursuant to the *School Act* is issued in alignment with AP – 156 Appendix Public Conduct on School Property.
