ADMINISTRATIVE COMMITTEES

Background

The Superintendent will establish such permanent or ad hoc committees as necessary for the proper administration of Board policies and District administrative procedures, and for the improvement of educational programs.

Procedures

- 1. The membership, composition, and responsibilities of such committees will be defined by the Superintendent and may be changed as required. In order that each group may work as effectively as possible, the Superintendent will explain clearly the group's function and the way it is to make its recommendations.
- 2. Committees of professional and support staff members will be established, maintained, and charged in accordance with applicable negotiated agreements or as considered necessary by the Superintendent or the administrative staff.
