The Vancouver School Board welcomes secondary school international students to apply to its international student program for the 2025-26 school year. Our secondary schools currently follow a semester system where students study 4 courses per semester. Detailed profiles of our secondary schools are available by request: intered@vsb.bc.ca. Check with a homestay provider to ensure that homestay placement is possible around your preferred schools.

September 2025 entry

Orientation is planned for August 26-29, 2025 and classes begin September 2, 2025.

Please note that:

- school placement depends on many factors, including the available school grade spaces, the applicant's age and grade level and anticipated English level. School spaces are limited and subject to change.
- The international program offers English as a second language (ELL) courses for students, as needed. It does not offer special learning needs supports for students.
- Applicants are normally placed in their Canadian age-grade correlated grade.
- Please know that BC high school graduation takes longer than 10 months to complete; VSB schools do not offer accelerated graduation completion within 10 months.
- Early applications strongly encouraged. Application deadline is <u>April 30, 2025</u>.

Elementary School Applications for September 2025 entry (for students born 2013-2019, grades 1-7)

Elementary student applications will close when available spaces are full. All elementary students must live in Vancouver with a parent, aunt/uncle or grandparent – homestay is not acceptable. Elementary students are placed at grade levels with the same-age students. Orientation for parents of elementary students is planned for August 26, 2025 and classes begin September 2, 2025.

Do not list these schools with NO available spaces: Maple Grove, Quilchena, Shaughnessy, Laurier, Jamieson, Cavell, False Creek, McKechnie, Carr, Sexsmith, David Lloyd George, Norma Rose Point, Bayview, Lord Roberts, Tyee & all downtown schools, and others.
