To graduate in BC, you will need to complete:

- 52 credits from required courses
- 28 credits from electives
- Three stand-alone Provincial Graduation Assessments
 - Graduation Numeracy Assessment in grade 10
 - Graduation Literacy Assessment in grade 10
 - Graduation Literacy Assessment in grade 12
- Effective the 2023/24 school year, all students working toward a B.C. Certificate of Graduation ("Dogwood Diploma"), must successfully complete at least 4 credits in Indigenous-focused coursework. There is no change to the total number of credits required to graduate, which remains at 80.
