



Study Block Application

Lord Byng Secondary School values a broad-based education in which students study a variety of disciplines to gain a better working knowledge of themselves and the world around them. Accordingly, students are expected to enroll in a complete and balanced educational program to prepare them for a lifetime of opportunities and change.

To qualify for a study block, senior students must have a plan to meet graduation requirements while taking less than a full schedule at Byng (students and parents/guardians are responsible for verification of graduation requirements—our counsellors support families with this process as well).

It's important that students with study blocks respect the learning environment for students in classes. Students on study blocks are expected to use the time to work on course material at home (particularly when the study falls in the first or last block), in the cafeteria, or in the library. In the event of an emergency (earthquake or fire, for example), please go to the tennis courts and check in with the office staff there.
