

# ARCHITECTURAL/STRUCTURAL CADD AND GRAPHICS TECHNICIAN

## Program Outline

This program offers two areas of specialization: Architectural CADD and Graphics Technician and Structural CADD and Graphics Technician.

These programs offer training for a variety of applications in architecture, building construction and industrial applications. CADD (Computer-Aided Drafting and Design) is an integral part of these drafting programs.

All students begin in September and must complete a drafting and CADD core and specialty.

## Application Process - apply in Grade 11

Start by visiting [careerprograms.vsb.bc.ca](http://careerprograms.vsb.bc.ca) to download an application. Students are encouraged to discuss the application with a school counsellor and family.

Specific details about the Orientation Session will be included in the acceptance letter. Students must attend along with a parent or guardian.

## Program Location & Intake Dates

This dual credit certificate program takes place at the BCIT campus in Burnaby.

The program runs from September through June. Class hours are from 7am to 1:30pm, Monday to Friday.

### Eligibility

This program is available to students who hold Canadian citizenship or Permanent Resident status and who attend a Vancouver School Board school or alternative program.

Foundations of Math 11 or Pre-Calculus Math 11

### Recommended Courses

Drafting 10 or 11 (if available)  
Any Tech Studies or Visual Art courses

### Funding Commitment

Tuition will be paid by the VSB for the first level of training. Students are expected to pay for program supplies, books - approximately \$1300.
