PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY:

Please use the “Student Online Course Selection” instructions (last page of this form) to help you enter your requests into MyEducationBC. The portal will be open for course selection between January 15-February 6.

1. You must enter your course requests into MyEducationBC to ensure that your requests are included in the first round of computer-generated schedules. Deadline: February 6, 2026
2. You also must include alternate choices to ensure that if your first requests are not available, you will more likely receive your second or third choice as opposed to a random course. Including ONLY your primary requests DOES NOT guarantee that you will receive your first choices.
3. Grade 12s must take eight courses for a full timetable or can choose to select 7 courses and a Study Block. Being a Peer Tutor or a CS student is also an elective option open to both Grade 11s and 12s, but students can have a Peer Tutor / CS class only once in Grade 11 or 12.
4. You must enter your requests into MyEdBC AND submit this paper form to your counsellor.
5. Please hand in this form to your counsellor by putting it in the envelope on the door of room 118 in the counselling suite. Final deadline for form submission: February 6th, 2026.

Program Planning for Grade 12 should be based on fulfilling graduation requirements (see p. 4-5 in Course Planning Guide) and post-secondary program requirements if that is your intended pathway. Please choose carefully because courses are likely not available if you change your mind. I recommend researching the admissions requirements for three (3) post-secondary institutions and two (2) programs within each of those institutions.

*Learning Hub (formerly called Skills) blocks are not given based solely on student/parent request. The Resource department determines which students will be recommended for a block. Reminder that as of the 2026 school year this class will not be credited.

Remember that an Indigenous Focus course is a graduation requirement (English First Peoples 10, English First Peoples 12 or Contemporary Indigenous Studies 12. Make sure that you have taken 1 of these!)

If planning to do summer school: also fill out the summer school letter of intent form (found in counselling suite)

How to Enter your courses on MyEd BC:

1. Log on to your MyEd portal. If you don't have access to your account, email kitsswitchboard@vsb.bc.ca to ask for help and/or a password reset
2. To enter your course requests, select "My Info" top tab and then the "Request" side tab. You will see information and instructions about course selections
3. Click on the "Select" button and a list of courses will appear
4. More than one page of requests will be available to choose from. Use the forward and back arrows on the top left to move between pages of requests. Select your course requests by placing a check mark next to the courses you choose and click "OK". Be sure to also choose your alternates!
5. Do not leave notes for your counsellor on MyEd. Please write them on the course planning sheet.

6. When you are finished, hit the “Post” button to submit your course request. You can change your requests in MyEd as long as the window is open, until February 6th.
