MYED BC: Please read the following instructions carefully!

Please use the attached “MYED Course Request” instructions to enter your requests into MYED BC. The portal will be open for you to enter courses and make any changes you want between January 15th and February 6th 2026.


1. You must enter your course requests into MYED BC to ensure your requests are included in the first round of computer-generated schedules.
2. You must include two alternate choices for each elective you are requesting. If your first choice is not available, the computer will try and give you your 2nd or 3rd choice of elective rather than something random.
3. You **MUST** enter your courses on MYED BC by February 6^h AND submit your course request sheet to Mr. Gummow (counselling suite) by February 12th. You can put your sheet in the envelope on my door – room 119.
4. **MYED HELP SESSIONS:** If you need help entering your courses onto MYED, please come to the counselling suite during FIT on Thursday January 29th or Tuesday February 3rd. You will need to know how to login to MYED before these help sessions. Please email kitsswitchboard@vsb.bc.ca if you are locked out of your MYED account.

How to enter your courses into MYED.

To enter your course requests, select “MY INFO” (top tab) and then the “REQUEST” (side tab) buttons. You will then see instructions and information about course selection....**READ THROUGH THESE CAREFULLY!**

Click on the “select” button and a list of courses will appear.

There will be 3 pages of elective requests to choose from. Use the forward and back buttons as shown here to cycle through them:
