I appreciate the work and collaboration of all of our students, staff, families, and contractors throughout this process.


# No Winter Concert

# School Liaison Officer Program

In November 2022, the Vancouver School Board approved a revised School Liaison Officer (SLO) program, effective from the current school year. The initiative aligns with the commitment to fostering safe and welcoming schools, acknowledging potential discomfort with police presence and encouraging communication about specific needs or considerations. School liaison officers, integral members of school

communities, aim to be supportive and positive, undergoing specialized training. Emphasizing diversity, they wear casual uniforms, use unmarked vehicles, and carry less visible firearms while delivering safety programs and offering guidance. Student interaction is not obligatory, and questions or concerns can be addressed directly to the principal.

Dear DLG community,

In November 2022, trustees of the Vancouver School Board approved a motion to implement a revised School Liaison Officer (SLO) program beginning this school year. This program has been mainly at secondary schools since September. Elementary school communities can also benefit from the support and guidance of police officers who work within the program.

Occasionally, we may invite one of the program's officers to our school. This may be to participate in a school event, to provide a presentation, to share other information with our school community or to ensure safety at the school. We will provide you with advance notice if an officer is invited to the school to participate in an event or presentation. We will also share details about the focus of the event or the information they will provide.

The revised program is a part of our ongoing commitment to foster safe and welcoming schools. But we understand that some people may not be comfortable with police at school. Please let us know if you or your child has specific needs or considerations.

School liaison officers are valued members of school communities. Like other educators and staff at DLG, their goal is to be a supportive and positive presence. They are of diverse ethnic and cultural backgrounds and have received specialized training to excel in this unique role. Officers will wear casual uniforms, utilize unmarked vehicles and carry less visible firearms. They deliver safety and crime prevention programs. They are also available to provide advice and guidance to students, staff and student-families who seek support. However, there is no obligation for students to interact with them.

If you have any questions about the program or want to let us know about specific considerations for you or your child's comfort, please reach out to me.
