The PAC supports and enhances the educational opportunities available to all our students.



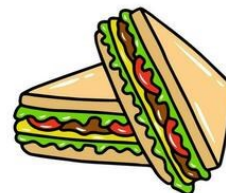

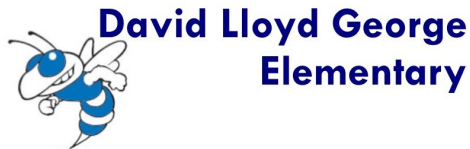
