Report Cards Going Home Today: Tuesday, March 12

Report Cards, also known as Learning Updates, will be going home with your child(ren) today (Tuesday, March 12)

As last year, teachers will use proficiency scales (Emerging, Developing, Proficient, and Extending) to evaluate students and not letter grades.

Learning Updates will be sent home three times per year this school year with the dates being the following:

- December 1, 2023
- March 12, 2024
- June 24, 2024

Student Hot Lunch for April: Deadline to Order is this Thursday, March 14—Reminder



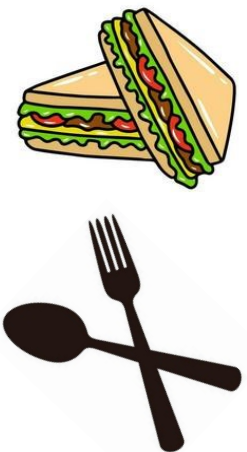
A reminder for families who order PAC Hot Lunch for Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Fridays that the **deadline to order is Thursday, March 14.**
