DLG PAC will be selling frozen yogurt for end of school day distribution on both Friday, May 31 and Friday, June 21.

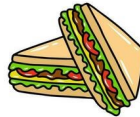

Online ordering process

1. Go to www.shopfunds.ca and select REGISTER AS A SHOPPER from the left TOOLBOX panel.
2. Register ONE time only. Username and password are case sensitive.
After inputting your information, click on the Register button at the bottom of the page.
3. Select Find a Group from the left TOOL BOX panel.
4. Enter David Lloyd George in the Name/Keyword box and click Search.
5. Select the checkbox in front of David Lloyd George Elementary and click on the Add button.
6. Enter 100 before the percentage sign under Split (%) and click on the Save button.
7. Select Order Cards from the left TOOL BOX panel. Select New Order from the right side of the page. In the Ordered For drop down menu, select David Lloyd George Elementary. Enter your child's name, Division and/or teacher's name in Notes. Notes are only viewable by DLG PAC and not by ShopFunds.
8. Enter the quantity of gift cards you wish to purchase under QTY. When you have completed your order, click on the Save button at the top or bottom of the page.
If you wish to save your order to be edited and submitted later, click on the Back to Order Centre button.
If you are ready to submit your order, click on the Confirm Order button. Once you see a Shopping Cart summary page, click on the Check Out button to complete submission.
When placing orders for others, you can place either multiple orders or one large order.
9. The Shopping Cart summary will provide you with the total amount due to DLG PAC.

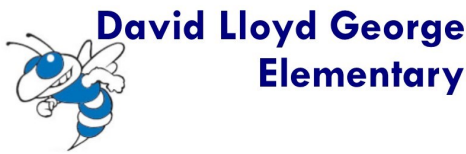
A one-time \$50 administration fee applies for new participants.
