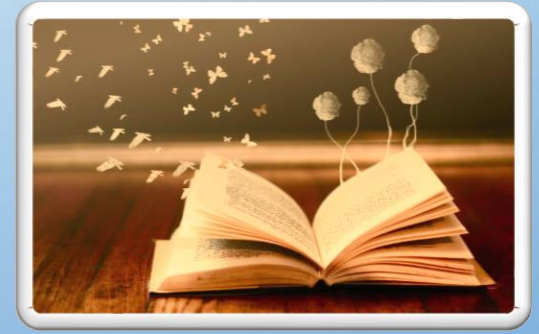
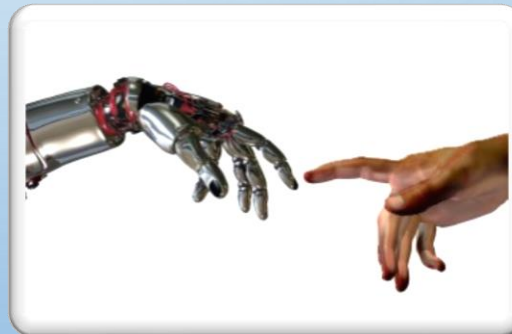



I like variety. I want to read, write, discuss and develop all my English language skills throughout the year – STUDENT C


I really enjoy learning about people. I want to learn about Indigenous culture and Reconciliation, along with practicing my writing and speaking skills – STUDENT D

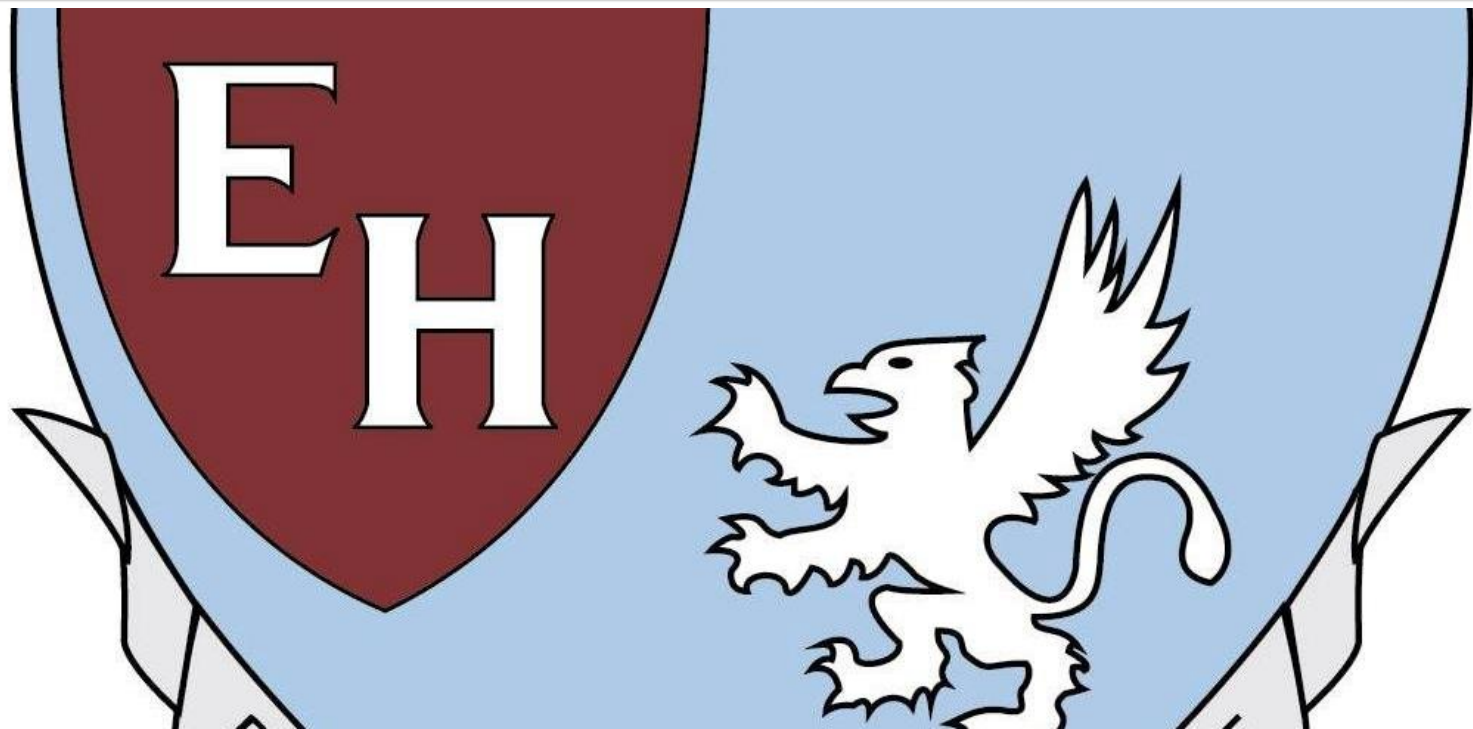
