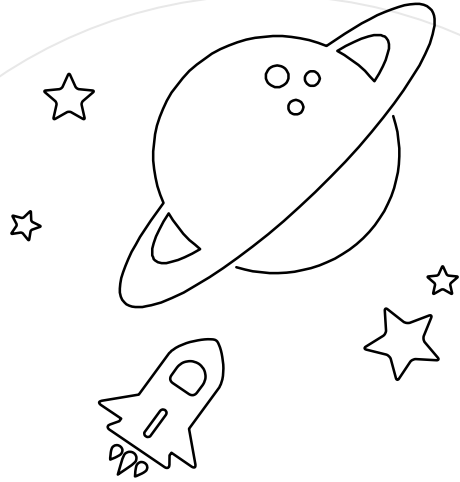

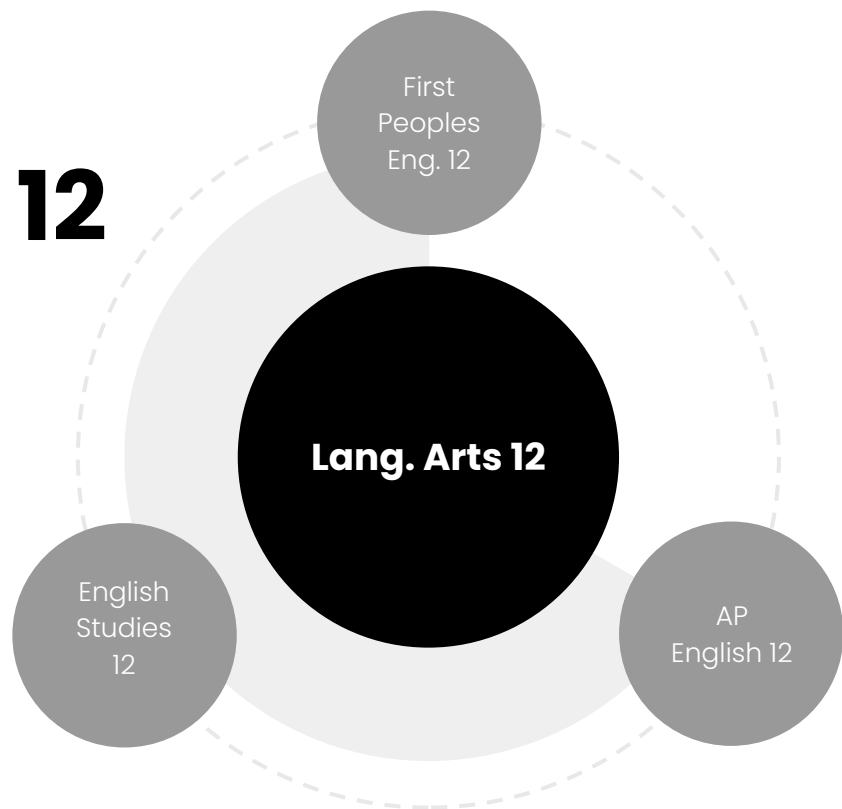

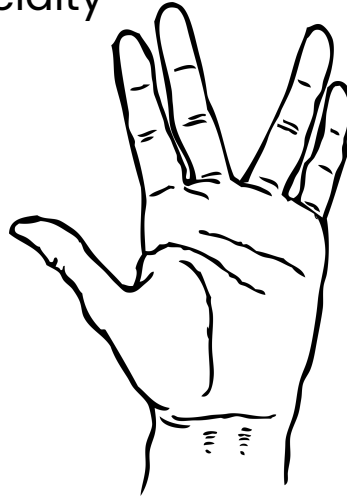

AP Classes

1

Exam happens in May

Students can take AP Courses and choose if they want to write the exam.

2

1st year Uni – level class

Unis will recognize AP marks and students can choose to go into the next level. Typically one AP class is one term class at Uni.

3

AP recognition

Some Unis will award AP marks by giving extra marks. Eg. If you achieve 80% in AP it will translate to 86%.

Study Block (Spares)

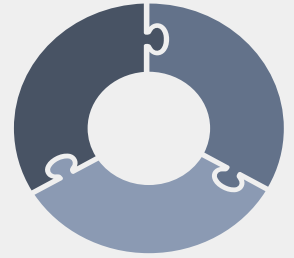

I. BC Certificate of Graduation (Dogwood Diploma)

The BC Certificate of Graduation, or Dogwood Diploma, is awarded to students who successfully complete the provincial graduation requirements. To graduate, students require at least 80 credits total.

Of these 80 credits:

- 52 credits are required from the following:
 - Physical and Health Education 10 (4 credits).
 - Science 10 (4 credits), and a Science 11 or 12 (4 credits).
 - Social Studies 10 (4 credits), and a Social Studies 11 or 12 (4 credits).
 - A Math 10 (4 credits), and a Math 11 or 12 course (4 credits).
 - A Language Arts 10, 11, and a required 12 course (4 credits required at each Grade, 12 credits total).
 - An Arts Education 10, 11, or 12 and/or an Applied Design, Skills, and Technologies 10, 11, or 12 (4 credits total).
 - Career-Life Education (4 credits), and Career-Life Connections (4 credits).
- At least 28 credits must be elective course credits.
- At least 16 credits must be at the Grade 12 level, including a required Language Arts 12 course and the Career-Life Connections course.

In addition, students must also complete three Provincial Graduation Assessments:

- Grade 10 Literacy Assessment.
- Grade 10 Numeracy Assessment.
- Grade 12 Literacy Assessment.



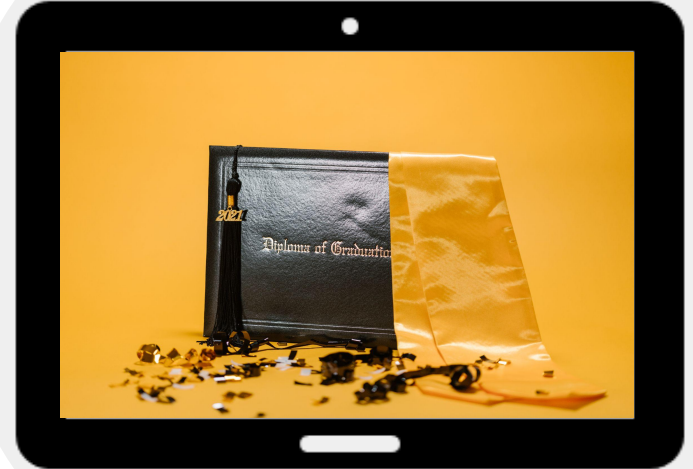

- High school diploma – is a MUST to apply to Universities!!!
- Some Faculties require a personal profile but not all
- Some post-secondary institutions will offer admissions based on Grade 11 marks (eg. BCIT, UoA)



Second Language Requirements

(not a grad requirement)

- Most Universities don't require students to complete Language 11.
- SFU will accept an Introductory Language 11.
- UBC will accept Language 11
- UVIC doesn't require Language 11.
- Language 12 super useful if applying to Faculty of Arts.
- ELL background students may be eligible for Language 10, 11 &/or 12 credit.
- Each University & each Faculty have specific requirements so do CHECK!



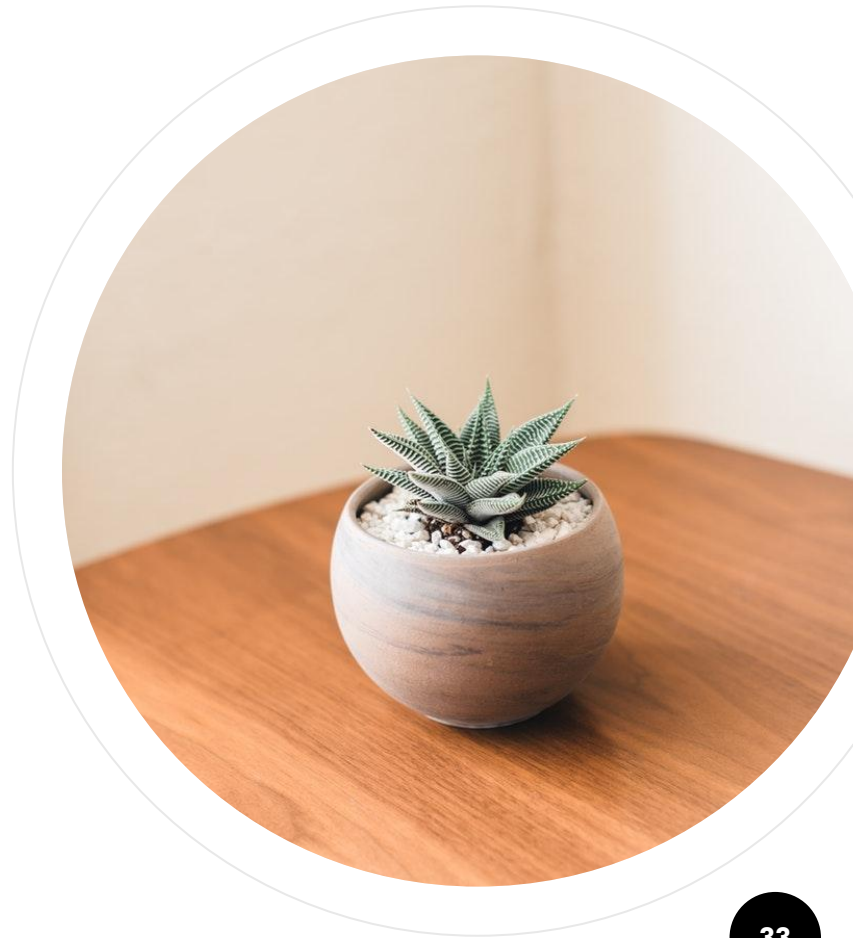

University Requirements

- Every University is a little different so make sure to read their requirements and ... FOLLOW THEIR STEP BY STEP INSTRUCTIONS EXACTLY
- Each University & Faculty has specific requirements
- Generally English 12 PLUS 3 or 4 or 5 other Academically Approved Grade 12 Courses
- Check out a list of Academically Approved Course
- Some Universities/Faculties have broad admissions process (i.e. personal profile)



College Requirements and College to University Transfer



- BC College acceptance: first come first serve basis, so apply online asap to secure your spot
- Many Colleges open applications after Oct. 1st
- Certain programs have course requirements eg. Nursing
- Colleges offer upgrading opportunities eg. retaking gr. 12 courses
- University Transfer means you start studying at College then transfer to University to complete your studies.
- University will recognize the education you took at College
- Make sure you look at University Transfer Guide
- Admissions averages to transfer from College into University are not as high as from High School straight into University
- 1 year = Certificate
- 2 years = Diploma
- 2 years of College + 2 years of University = Bachelor Degree



Self Reporting

- Done through your Uni. Student center (eg. Solus for Queens)
- Self Report when the window for self reporting opens
- Self-report only what is on your official documents eg. Report card
- Universities will check your marks when they grade the official transcript directly from the Ministry/BCeID
- Admissions averages typically start high and lower as June approaches
