Dear Grandview/¿uuqinak'uuh Community:

It is hard to believe that we have been back in school for a month. September is always an exciting and busy time at schools. We hope that everyone has settled into their routines. We look forward to all the events October will bring.

A reminder that students have a designated drop-off and pick-up schedule and location which were shared by classroom teachers. It is essential to be on time for your child's designated drop-off and pick-up schedule. If your child is late, please have them check in at the office. For continued health and safety reasons we will continue to ask families/caregivers to make an appointment with office or staff member in regards to meetings. We appreciate your continued support in keeping our school community healthy and safe.

Families/caregivers, please note that we have staff supervision starting at 8:40 before school and from 3:03 to 3:23 after-school. Please do not bring your child to school earlier unless there has been a prior arrangement with your child's teacher, or they have a special school commitment because there will be no supervision. In the afternoon, staff supervision ends at 3:23 pm. If you are going to be late, please call the school by 3pm. If it is after staff supervision time, your child will be asked to wait in the office or by the front entrance. *Please note after 3:23 pm it is the parent/caregiver's responsibility to supervise their child/ren if remaining on the school grounds to play on the playground, etc.*

Students participated in the annual Terry Fox Run this past month. Thank you to staff for organizing and to all who supported this event. I know that staff and students participated in discussions and learning opportunities leading up to the day. What an amazing way to show our Support and Respect to those affected by cancer by running in Terry's name, and the names of the many family members and friends that have touched our lives.

Thank you to all the families/caregivers that were able to attend the Meet the Teacher event. It was great to have everyone back into the school visiting. We are looking forward to planning future events.

This year the Foundation Skills Assessment (FSA) test is from October 3 – Nov. 10. The (FSA) is an annual provincial assessment

that will be conducted in Grade 4 and 7 classrooms across British Columbia. An email was shared with parents/caregivers of grade 4 and 7 students providing details about the assessment.

On October 20, officially "ShakeOut BC Day," millions of people worldwide will practice how to Drop, Cover, and Hold On at 2:00 PM during the *Great ShakeOut Earthquake Drill!* The standard drill uses simple steps to inform all students how to perform "Drop, Cover, and Hold On" – a quake-safe action designed to protect lives and prevent injuries from falling furniture and flying objects that can become projectiles during ground shaking. Later in May, students will also be participating, in "The Big One at 2pm" with all schools in the Vancouver School District.

Although the weather is still unusually summer-like, we are settling into fall and anticipate winter soon. We need to remember that students are going out to play during recess and lunch. Please ensure your children are dressed appropriately for the seasonal weather. It is often cold and/or wet weather. Children are encouraged to dress in layers too, just in case. Also, do not forget to label your child's clothing. We are often finding jackets, sweaters and umbrellas left behind. It would be nice to know who to return them to.

Cell Phones

A reminder to students and parents that cell phones <u>are not to</u> <u>be used during school hours unless it is being used for</u> <u>educational purposes, supervised by staff</u>. Students <u>should not</u> be using cell phones to phone home during school hours. If any calls are required, the classroom teacher or the office will contact families/caregivers. If a student does bring a cell phone to school, they are being asked to keep it in their backpack during the day, (this includes recess and lunch) either turned off or on silent mode. Please be advised that school is not responsible for any lost or damaged devices. Thank you for your support.
